

No Coast Junior Derby (NCJD) Scholarship Program

Updated 1.1.2023

*No Coast Junior Derby offers five scholarships per six month period to new & existing skaters on an as needed basis while supplies last. Scholarships are issued on a six month basis in conjunction with the Junior Roller Derby Association (JRDA) season. Applications will open December 1st, close January 15th for the first six month period, June 1st, close July 15th for the second six month period. Skaters are eligible for **ONE** scholarship per year. Please read below details for application and award timing requirements.*

One skater per household is eligible for scholarship. All other siblings will receive the multi-skater discount of 50% off normal tuition price.

● **Qualifications:**

- *Attendance requirements: Approved scholarship skaters must attend 70% of practices.*
- *Volunteer requirements: Eligible skaters/parents must commit to a minimum of four volunteer opportunities.*
- Be approved for Free/Reduced Lunch for LPS or other surrounding school district for the current school year or approved financial assistance program if attending private school
- Maintain an average grade of "C" or "2" in all classes
- For homeschool students only: Received exempt status with NDE for the current school year

● **Scholarship includes:**

- Free registration through one JRDA season or the remainder of the current JRDA season; whichever will occur upon skater registration and scholarship receipt.
 - The JRDA season runs annually JAN 1 - AUG 31. Eligible skaters on Furies will keep their scholarship through the end of the competitive season.
 - Skater Accident Insurance is currently included in the cost of skater registration. In the event that skater insurance is not included in the registration cost, this will be of no cost to the scholarship recipient during the same period of free registration.
- Gear
 - Helmet
 - Pads (knee pads, elbow pads, wrist guards)
 - Mouthguard
 - Quad Roller Skates
- Jersey
 - Applies to Furies skaters only; Thunderpups and Skate schoolers are not required to wear a jersey.
 - For skaters who do not already have a jersey and who have leveled up to Furies during the scholarship session.
 - A jersey will only be provided to skaters during sessions where Sanctioned games are scheduled.

- ***Promise to Return Gear:***

- Scholarship recipient(s) agree(s) to the following
 - All gear, excluding mouthguards, will be returned to NCJD after every completed session within the JRDA season.
 - If the skater quits, is injured and cannot play, or grows out of the gear, the safety gear and roller skaters must be returned to NCJD within 7 days of the last practice attended.
 - If the skater quits, they relinquish all rights to their derby name and derby number therefore, they must return the jersey to NCJD within 7 days of the last practice attended.

- ***Application Process***

- Traditional (non-homeschooled) Students:
 - Complete the registration form in the website in its entirety in the website <https://www.nocoastjuniorderby.com/scholarships>
 - You must register your skater for the session in which you are applying for the scholarship. Note: during registration, please select the payment method you would typically choose if you were not applying for the scholarship
 - Complete the NCJD scholarship application in the website following registration
 - Upload a copy of your Free/Reduced Lunch decision letter from LPS (or surrounding school district) to the scholarship application or approved financial assistance document for private school
 - Supply a copy of the most recent report card for scholarship applicant
 - A copy of the scholarship recipient's quarterly report card will be required during the fall, winter and spring sessions.
- Homeschool students only:
 - Complete the registration form in the website in its entirety in the website <https://www.nocoastjuniorderby.com/scholarships>
 - You must register your skater for the session in which you are applying for the scholarship. Note: during registration, please select the payment method you would typically choose if you were not applying for the scholarship
 - Complete the NCJD scholarship application in the website following registration
 - Upload a copy of the letter signed by the Commissioner of Education "acknowledging" your choice to receive exempt status to the scholarship application
 - Supply a copy of the most recent report card for scholarship applicant
 - A copy of the scholarship recipient's quarterly report card will be required during the fall, winter and spring sessions.
